 - Safe and welfare checks
 - Developing and maintaining strong and meaningful relationships with our children and young people

• Oversight and continuous improvement of independence planning for those young people turning 16

- Alongside the social work team, providing guidance and support in respect of post 16 and post 18 education, training and career options
- Working alongside the wider team to devise and deliver aspirational guidance and workshops on future planning
